

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT  
119-22  
OFFERED BY MRS. MCCLAIN DELANEY OF  
MARYLAND**

At the end of subtitle A, of title IV, add the following:

**SEC. 4114. CONDITIONAL RESTORATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF LAW  
APPLICABLE TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

Section 10106, and the amendments made by that section, of Public Law 119-21 are repealed, and the provisions of law amended by such sections are restored as if such sections had not been enacted into law, until the Administrator of the Food and Nutrition Service of the Department of Agriculture, and all State agencies (as defined in section 3 of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2012)), issuing reports evaluating and certifying that any changes made by section 10106, or the amendments made by section 10106, to the supplemental nutrition assistance program will not result in —

- (1) a decrease in benefits to eligible individuals;
- (2) a in reduction in participation due to changes in eligibility for individuals; or
- (3) a reduction in other State or locally-funded services to low-income families in comparison to what would have occurred in the absence of section 10106.
