

**Amendment to the Financial Services and General Government and National Security, Department of State, and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2026**

**OFFERED BY MR. MASSIE OF KENTUCKY**

In Title I of Division B, strike the following:

“National Endowment for Democracy

For grants made by the Department of State to the National Endowment for Democracy, as authorized by the National Endowment for Democracy Act (22 U.S.C. 4412), \$315,000,000, to remain available until expended, of which \$210,316,000 shall be allocated in the traditional and customary manner, including for the core institutes, and \$104,684,000 shall be for democracy programs: *Provided*, That the requirements of section 7062(a) of this Act shall not apply to funds made available under this heading: *Provided further*, That funds appropriated under this heading shall be apportioned to the Endowment not later than 60 days after the date of enactment of this Act.”;

In Title VII of Division B, strike Section 7032; and

In Division C, insert at the end the following:

**“Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. No Funds for the National Endowment for Democracy.**

Notwithstanding any other provision of any other division of this Act, funds appropriated or otherwise made available by division B of this Act or other Acts making appropriations for the Department of State, foreign operations, and related programs, including provisions of Acts providing supplemental appropriations for the Department of State, foreign operations, and related programs, may not be used to fund or support the National Endowment for Democracy.”
