2 (a) NOTIFICATION OF PERFORMANCE-BASED STAND3 ARDS REVIEW.—The Secretary of Transportation shall in4 vite the public to provide input to identify those regula5 tions, guidance, and policies of the Department that—

- 6 (1) in current form, establish prescriptive re7 quirements for regulated entities; and
- 8 (2) are able to be replaced, consistent with Fed9 eral law, providing an equal or higher level of safety,
 10 with performance-based standards.

(b) REPORT AND PLAN.—Not later than 180 days
after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
submit to Congress a report on the Department's plan to
address feedback from the public requested under subsection (a) that includes—

16 (1) a list identifying each prescriptive regula17 tion, guidance document, and policy that was deter18 mined by the Secretary, based on input from the

(c) PLAN IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 2 years
after the date on which the report required under subsection (b) is submitted to Congress, the Secretary shall
complete implementation of the plan described in that subsection.

16 (d) RULEMAKING REQUIREMENT.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—To the maximum extent possible, the Secretary shall ensure that regulations,
guidance, and policies issued by the Department on
and after the date of enactment of this Act are
issued in the form of performance-based standards
and not as prescriptive requirements for regulated
entities.

24 (2) JUSTIFICATIONS.—The Secretary shall
25 make available to the public a justification for each

regulation, guidance document, and policy issued by
 the Department on and after the date of enactment
 of this Act that is not issued in the form of a per formance-based standard.

5 (e) DEPARTMENT DEFINED.—In this section, the
6 term "Department" means the Department of Transpor7 tation, including each modal administration thereof.
