

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8595, AS REPORTED

OFFERED BY MR. MASSIE OF KENTUCKY

Page 156, beginning on line 19, strike subsection (d) of section 7041 and redesignate subsections (e) through (g) as subsections (d) through (f) respectively; and

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

“SEC. __. No funds for Jordan.

(a) None of the funds made available under this Act shall be obligated or expended for Jordan.

(b) The amounts otherwise made available by this Act for the following accounts are hereby reduced by the following amounts:

(1) “Foreign Military Financing Program”, \$475,000,000.

(2) “National Security Investment Programs”, \$500,000,000.

(3) “Global Health Programs”, \$845,100,000.

(4) “Security Sector Programs”, \$50,000,000.

(5) “Funds Appropriated to the President International Military Education and Training”, \$50,000,000.

(6) “Nonproliferation, anti-terrorism, demining, and related programs”, \$29,900,000

(7) United States Emergency Refugee and Migration Assistance Fund”, \$50,000,000

(8) “Democracy Fund”, \$100,000,000.
