At the end of subtitle C of title XXXI, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 31 SENSE OF CONGRESS ON THE ATOMS FOR
2	PEACE PROGRAM.
3	It is the sense of Congress that the United States
4	should once again adhere to the principals of the Atoms
5	for Peace Program established by President Dwight D. Ei-
6	senhower, specifically by carrying out, to the maximum ex-
7	tent practicable, the Program's three main economic and
8	national security objectives, which were—
9	(1) to prevent the spread of nuclear weapons;
10	(2) to make the United States the leader in nu-
11	clear power, ensuring that the United States main-
12	tains dominance in nuclear safety, security, nuclear
13	technology development, and nuclear trade; and
14	(3) to ensure the United States benefits from
15	geopolitical relationships when providing foreign as-
16	sistance to countries in relation to bolstering their
17	power supplies.
