

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8
OFFERED BY MR. BABIN OF TEXAS

At the end of subtitle C of title VII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 7____. STUDY ON IMPLEMENTATION OF ACCREDITA-**
2 **TION REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY DENTAL**
3 **TREATMENT FACILITIES.**

4 (a) STUDY REQUIRED.—The Inspector General of
5 the Department of Defense shall conduct a study on the
6 implementation of section 744(b)(4) of the National De-
7 fense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021 (Public Law
8 116–283; 10 U.S.C. 1071 note) with respect to military
9 dental treatment facilities. Such study shall include the
10 following:

11 (1) An identification of the number and per-
12 centage of military dental treatment facilities that
13 have not achieved accreditation as required under
14 such section 744(b)(4) as of the date of the study.

15 (2) An analysis of any barriers, including ad-
16 ministrative or operational barriers, impeding the
17 achievement of such accreditation requirement with
18 respect to military dental treatment facilities.

1 (3) An assessment of the resources, including
2 personnel, training, and infrastructure resources,
3 necessary to achieve full compliance with such ac-
4 creditation requirement.

5 (4) An estimate of the costs necessary to bring
6 any unaccredited military dental treatment facility
7 into compliance with such accreditation requirement.

8 (5) Recommendations for any administrative,
9 legislative, or other action necessary to ensure the
10 full implementation of such accreditation require-
11 ment.

12 (b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
13 of the enactment of this Act, the Inspector General of the
14 Department of Defense shall submit to the Committees
15 on Armed Services of the House of Representatives and
16 the Senate a report on the study under subsection (a).
17 Such report shall include—

18 (1) the findings of the study;

19 (2) a plan to ensure compliance with section
20 744(b)(4) of the National Defense Authorization Act
21 for Fiscal Year 2021 (Public Law 116–283; 10
22 U.S.C. 1071 note); and

23 (3) any recommendations by the Inspector Gen-
24 eral for additional resources or legislative authority
