

**AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE AMENDMENT TO  
H.R. 5325  
OFFERED BY MR. BABIN OF TEXAS**

At the end of division C (before the short title), insert the following:

1       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. (a) None of the funds made available  
2 by this Act may be used to admit to the United States  
3 an alien as a refugee under section 207 of the Immigration  
4 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1157) who is a citizen or  
5 national of Afghanistan, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Syria, or  
6 Yemen, or in the case of an alien having no nationality,  
7 whose country of last habitual residence was in such a  
8 country until such time as—

9       (1) the Secretary of Homeland Security, in consulta-  
10 tion with the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investiga-  
11 tion and the Secretary of State, establishes a process to  
12 ensure that aliens who are inadmissible under section  
13 212(a)(3)(B) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
14 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)(B)) are not admitted to the United  
15 States as refugees;

16       (2) the Secretary of Homeland Security, in consulta-  
17 tion with the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investiga-  
18 tion, establishes a process to ensure the monitoring of

1 aliens who are present in the United States who were ad-  
2 mitted to the United States as refugees;

3 (3) the Secretary of Homeland Security provides to  
4 Congress a report on the processes described in para-  
5 graphs (1) and (2) in both classified and unclassified  
6 forms; and

7 (4) there is enacted a joint resolution which gives the  
8 Secretary of Homeland Security authority to admit such  
9 aliens, the matter after the resolving clause of which is  
10 as follows: “That Congress approves of the admission of  
11 aliens as refugees under section 207 of the Immigration  
12 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1157) who are citizens or  
13 nationals of Afghanistan, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Syria, or  
14 Yemen, or in the case of aliens having no nationality,  
15 whose country of last habitual residence was in such a  
16 country.”.

17 (b) Subsection (a) does not prohibit the use of funds  
18 made available by this Act to provide for the safety of ref-  
19 ugees outside of the United States, including providing for  
20 housing, food, and medical aid for such individuals.
