At the end of subtitle E of title X, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 10 ASSISTANCE IN SUPPORT OF DEPARTMENT OF
2	DEFENSE ACCOUNTING FOR MISSING UNITED
3	STATES GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL.
4	(a) In General.—Section 408 of title 10, United
5	States Code, is amended as follows:
6	(1) In the heading, by striking " Equipment
7	and training of foreign personnel to as-
8	sist in" and inserting "Assistance in support
9	of''.
10	(2) In subsection (b), by adding at the end the
11	following new paragraph:
12	"(5) Funds.".
13	(3) In subsection (c), by adding at the end the
14	following: "No such assistance may be provided to a
15	state sponsor of terrorism."
16	(4) By striking subsection (d) and inserting the
17	following:

1	"(d) Limitations.—The amount of assistance pro-
2	vided under this section in any fiscal year—
3	"(1) for a single field recovery activity may not
4	exceed—
5	"(A) \$5,000,000; or
6	(B) \$10,000,000 once per fiscal year if
7	the Secretary of Defense determines that such
8	activity is exceptionally complex; and
9	"(2) may not exceed a total of \$25,000,000 to
10	all foreign nations combined.".
11	(5) In subsection (f)—
12	(A) by striking "Whenever" and inserting
13	"Not later than 60 days after"; and
14	(B) by striking "congressional defense
15	committees" and inserting "appropriate con-
16	gressional committees".
17	(6) By adding at the end the following new sub-
18	sections:
19	"(g) Annual Report.—Not later than December 31
20	of each year, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the
21	appropriate congressional committees a report on all as-
22	sistance provided under this section during the preceding
23	fiscal year. Each such report shall identify each foreign
24	nation to which assistance was provided and include a de-

1	scription of the type and amount of the assistance pro-
2	vided.
3	"(h) Definitions.—In this section:
4	"(1) The term 'appropriate congressional com-
5	mittees' means the following:
6	"(A) The congressional defense commit-
7	tees.
8	"(B) The Committee on Foreign Affairs of
9	the House of Representatives.
10	"(C) The Committee on Foreign Relations
11	of the Senate.
12	"(2) The term 'state sponsor of terrorism' has
13	the meaning given such term in section 107 of the
14	Countering America's Adversaries Through Sanc-
15	tions Act (Public Law 115–44; 22 U.S.C. 9406).".
16	(b) Table of Sections Amendment.—The table of
17	sections at the beginning of chapter 20 of title 10, United
18	States Code, is amended by striking the item relating to
19	section 408 and inserting the following new item:
	"408. Assistance in support of Department of Defense accounting for missing United States Government personnel.".
