At the end of subtitle E of title V, insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 5____. AIR FORCE RAPID RESPONSE LANGUAGE PILOT 2 PROGRAM.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the
5 Air Force shall establish a pilot program to enable—

6 (1) agile response to sudden requirements for
7 skills in new languages where capability is limited or
8 non-existent;

9 (2) agile response to surge for any language re10 quired due to responses to conflict, humanitarian
11 disaster, or other military requirements; and

(3) development of innovative language learning
technologies for delivering synchronous and asynchronous language training for Air Force linguists
and other Air Force language enabled personnel.

(b) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date
of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit
to the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate and

the Committee on Armed Services of the House of Rep resentatives, on the results of the pilot program, including
 the number of courses developed, the number of personnel
 trained, the languages taught, the proficiency levels at tained, response time to develop courses and train per sonnel, and availability for training personnel while on the
 job.

8 (c) BRIEFING.—Not later than July 1, 2025, the Sec-9 retary shall brief the Committees on Armed Services of 10 the Senate and House of Representatives on implementa-11 tion of this section and plans regarding continuing lan-12 guage education described in subsection (a).

13 (d) SUNSET.—The authority under this section shall14 expire on September 30, 2028.
