

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8146, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. BAIRD OF INDIANA**

Page 5, after line 4, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 4. TRANSFER OF BARRIER AND ROADWAY CONSTRU-**  
2 **CTION MATERIALS TO STATE GOVERNMENTS.**

3 (a) TRANSFER OF COVERED MATERIALS.—Begin-  
4 ning on the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
5 retary of Homeland Security shall transfer, without reim-  
6 bursement—

7 (1) all covered materials located, as of the date  
8 of the enactment of this Act, in Texas to the Gov-  
9 ernment of Texas;

10 (2) all covered materials located, as of the date  
11 of the enactment of this Act, in Arizona to the Gov-  
12 ernment of Arizona;

13 (3) all covered materials located, as of the date  
14 of the enactment of this Act, in New Mexico to the  
15 Government of New Mexico; and

16 (4) all covered materials located, as of the date  
17 of the enactment of this Act, in California to the  
18 Government of California.

19 (b) PHYSICAL RELOCATION OF MATERIALS.—The  
20 Secretary of Homeland Security shall be responsible for

1 the physical relocation of all covered materials transferred  
2 under this section to appropriate State-operated facilities.

3 (c) COVERED MATERIALS.—In this section, the term  
4 “covered materials” means all unused materials in the  
5 possession of the Federal Government that were pur-  
6 chased to construct roadways or physical barriers along  
7 the southern border of the United States.
