3 (a) TRANSFER OF COVERED MATERIALS.—Begin4 ning on the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec5 retary of Homeland Security shall transfer, without reim6 bursement—

- 7 (1) all covered materials located, as of the date
  8 of the enactment of this Act, in Texas to the Gov9 ernment of Texas;
- 10 (2) all covered materials located, as of the date
  11 of the enactment of this Act, in Arizona to the Gov12 ernment of Arizona;
- (3) all covered materials located, as of the date
  of the enactment of this Act, in New Mexico to the
  Government of New Mexico; and

16 (4) all covered materials located, as of the date
17 of the enactment of this Act, in California to the
18 Government of California.

19 (b) PHYSICAL RELOCATION OF MATERIALS.—The20 Secretary of Homeland Security shall be responsible for

the physical relocation of all covered materials transferred
 under this section to appropriate State-operated facilities.

3 (c) COVERED MATERIALS.—In this section, the term 4 "covered materials" means all unused materials in the 5 possession of the Federal Government that were pur-6 chased to construct roadways or physical barriers along 7 the southern border of the United States.
