

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-38

OFFERED BY MR. BAIRD OF INDIANA

Page 24, after line 14, insert the following:

1 (c) Beginning on the date of the enactment of this
2 Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall transfer,
3 without reimbursement—

4 (1) all covered materials located, as of the date
5 of the enactment of this Act, in Texas to the Gov-
6 ernment of Texas;

7 (2) all covered materials located, as of the date
8 of the enactment of this Act, in Arizona to the Gov-
9 ernment of Arizona;

10 (3) all covered materials located, as of the date
11 of the enactment of this Act, in New Mexico to the
12 Government of New Mexico; and

13 (4) all covered materials located, as of the date
14 of the enactment of this Act, in California to the
15 Government of California.

16 (d) The Secretary of Homeland Security shall be re-
17 sponsible for the physical relocation of all covered mate-
18 rials transferred under this section to appropriate State-
19 operated facilities.

1 (e) In this section, the term “covered materials”
2 means all unused materials in the possession of the Fed-
3 eral Government that were purchased to construct road-
4 ways or physical barriers along the southern border of the
5 United States.
