Page 24, after line 14, insert the following:

(c) Beginning on the date of the enactment of this
 Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall transfer,
 without reimbursement—

- 4 (1) all covered materials located, as of the date
  5 of the enactment of this Act, in Texas to the Gov6 ernment of Texas;
- 7 (2) all covered materials located, as of the date
  8 of the enactment of this Act, in Arizona to the Gov9 ernment of Arizona;
- 10 (3) all covered materials located, as of the date
  11 of the enactment of this Act, in New Mexico to the
  12 Government of New Mexico; and
- (4) all covered materials located, as of the date
  of the enactment of this Act, in California to the
  Government of California.

(d) The Secretary of Homeland Security shall be responsible for the physical relocation of all covered materials transferred under this section to appropriate Stateoperated facilities.

(e) In this section, the term "covered materials"
 means all unused materials in the possession of the Fed eral Government that were purchased to construct road ways or physical barriers along the southern border of the
 United States.
