3 "(b) COVERED VETERAN DEFINED.—In this section,

7 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
8 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by striking

(c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by subsection (a) shall apply with respect to requests for appointment scheduling occurring on or after the date that is 120
days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
