AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT OF H.R. 2838

OFFERED BY MS. BALDWIN OF WISCONSIN

At the end of title VI of the committee print, add the following:

1SEC. 612. VESSELS OF COAST GUARD OFFSHORE PATROL2CUTTER CLASS OF SHIPS.

(a) DOMESTIC MANUFACTURE OF MAIN PROPULSION
DIESEL ENGINES.—None of the funds authorized by this
Act may be used to design, develop, or procure any vessel
of the Coast Guard Offshore Patrol Cutter class of ships
unless the main propulsion diesel engines of the vessel are
manufactured in the United States by a domestically operated entity.

(b) AUTHORITY TO WAIVE.—The Secretary of Homeland Security may waive the application of subsection (a)
if the Secretary determines that only one domestically operated entity exists to design, develop, or procure the main
propulsion diesel engines referred to in subsection (a).
