

**AMENDMENT TO H. CON. RES. 112, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MS. BALDWIN OF WISCONSIN**

For each of fiscal years 2013 through 2022, increase the recommended levels of new budget authority and outlays set forth in paragraph (10) of section 102 (relating to Education, Training, Employment, and Social Services (500)) by \$3,505,000,000.

For each of fiscal years 2013 through 2022, increase the recommended levels of new budget authority set forth in paragraph (2) of section 101 and set forth in budget outlays paragraph (3) of section 101 by \$3,505,000,000.

For each of fiscal years 2013 through 2022 (except for fiscal year 2014), increase the recommended levels of Federal revenues set forth in paragraph (1)(A) of section 101 by \$5,100,000,000 for fiscal year 2013, \$4,500,000,000 for fiscal year 2015, \$4,800,000,000 for fiscal year 2016, \$5,300,000,000 for fiscal year 2017, \$5,700,000,000 for fiscal year 2018, \$6,100,000,000 for fiscal year 2019, \$6,400,000,000 for fiscal year 2020, \$6,700,000,000 for fiscal year 2021, and \$7,000,000,000 for fiscal year 2022.

For fiscal year 2014, decrease the recommended level of Federal revenues set forth in paragraph (1)(A) of section 101 by \$6,100,000,000.

For each of fiscal years 2013 through 2022 (except for fiscal year 2014), decrease the change in Federal revenues set forth in paragraph (1)(B) of section 101 by \$5,100,000,000 for fiscal year 2013, \$4,500,000,000 for fiscal year 2015, \$4,800,000,000 for fiscal year 2016, \$5,300,000,000 for fiscal year 2017, \$5,700,000,000 for fiscal year 2018, \$6,100,000,000 for fiscal year 2019, \$6,400,000,000 for fiscal year 2020, \$6,700,000,000 for fiscal year 2021, and \$7,000,000,000 for fiscal year 2022.

For fiscal year 2014, increase the change in Federal revenues set forth in paragraph (1)(B) of section 101 by \$6,100,000,000.

For each of fiscal years 2013 through 2022 (except for fiscal year 2014), decrease the on-budget deficits set forth in paragraph (4) of section 101 by \$1,595,000,000 for fiscal year 2013, \$995,000,000 for fiscal year 2015, \$1,295,000,000 for fiscal year 2016, \$1,795,000,000 for fiscal year 2017, \$2,195,000,000 for fiscal year 2018, \$2,595,000,000 for fiscal year 2019, \$2,895,000,000 for

fiscal year 2020, \$3,195,000,000 for fiscal year 2021,  
and \$3,495,000,000 for fiscal year 2022.

For fiscal year 2014, increase the on-budget deficit  
set forth in paragraph (4) of section 101 by  
\$9,605,000,000.
