OFFERED BY MR. BANKS OF INDIANA

At the end of subtitle C of title XVIII, add the following:

1	SEC. 18 DISCLOSURES OF GIFTS AND CONTRACTS RE-
2	CEIVED BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDU-
3	CATION FROM FOREIGN SOURCES.
4	Section 117 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20
5	U.S.C. 1011f) is amended—
6	(1) by amending paragraph (1) of subsection
7	(b) to read as follows:
8	"(1) For gifts received from or contracts en-
9	tered into with a foreign source other than a foreign
10	government, the aggregate dollar amount of the gifts
11	and contracts attributable to each such foreign
12	source.";
13	(2) by redesignating subsections (d) through (h)
14	as subsections (e) through (i), respectively
15	(3) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-
16	lowing:
17	"(d) Due Diligence Requirements.—Each insti-
18	tution that receives gifts or conditional gifts from or en-

1	ters into contracts or conditional contracts with a foreign
2	source shall establish, maintain, and administer appro-
3	priate, specific, and, where necessary, enhanced, due dili-
4	gence policies, procedures, and controls that enable the in-
5	stitution to independently verify when a gift or conditional
6	gift, or a contract or conditional contract, is from or with
7	a foreign source and shall report the specific identity of
8	each beneficial owner and real party in interest of each
9	such foreign source to the Secretary, including the specific
10	identity of any individual or entity that is—
11	"(1) a current or former official, officer, mem-
12	ber, employee, citizen, agent, or instrumentality of
13	the government of the People's Republic of China,
14	the Communist Party of China, or the People's Lib-
15	eration Army;
16	"(2) a current or former official, officer, mem-
17	ber, employee, citizen, agent, or instrumentality of
18	the government of Russian Federation;
19	"(3) a current or former official, officer, mem-
20	ber, employee, citizen, agent, or instrumentality of
21	the government of the Islamic Republic of Iran; or
22	"(4) a natural or legal person on the Specially
23	Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons List
24	maintained by the Office of Foreign Asset Control of

1	the Department of the Treasury or any agent or in-
2	strumentality of such a person.";
3	(4) in subsection (f), as so redesignated, by
4	striking "during business hours" and inserting "and
5	shall be prominently posted on a publicly accessible
6	website of the institution and on publicly accessible
7	website of the Department of Education"; and
8	(5) in subsection (i), as so redesignated—
9	(A) by amending subparagraph (B) of
10	paragraph (2) to read as follows:
11	"(B) a legal person—
12	"(i) created under the laws of or dom-
13	iciled in a foreign state or states; or
14	"(ii)(I) created under the laws of any
15	State of the United States or a trust terri-
16	tory or protectorate thereof; and
17	"(II) that is an instrumentality of or
18	substantially owned or controlled by a for-
19	eign source or by an agent acting on behalf
20	of a foreign source;"; and
21	(B) in paragraph (4)—
22	(i) by redesignating subparagraphs
23	(A) through (C) as clauses (i) through
24	(iii), respectively;

1	(ii) by striking "the term institution
2	means any institution, public or private
3	or, if a multicampus institution, any single
4	campus of such institution, in any State
5	that—" and inserting "the term institu-
6	tion'—
7	"(A) means any institution, public or pri-
8	vate, or, if a multicampus institution, any single
9	campus of such institution, in any State, that—
10	"; and
11	(iii) by adding at the end the fol-
12	lowing:
13	"(B) includes all natural and legal persons
14	such as employees, agents, contractors, founda-
15	tions, corporations, associations, and other
16	intermediaries, that operate substantially for
17	the benefit or under the auspices such an insti-
18	tution.''.
