## Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 117–54 Offered by Mr. Barr of Kentucky

At the end of subtitle B of title XIII, add the following:

## 1 SEC. 13\_. REPORT ON CHINESE SUPPORT TO RUSSIA WITH 2 RESPECT TO ITS UNPROVOKED INVASION OF 3 AND FULL-SCALE WAR AGAINST UKRAINE.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the 5 date of the enactment of this Act and every 90 days there-6 after, the Secretary of State, in consultation with the Sec-7 retary of Commerce and the Director of National Intelligence as appropriate, shall submit to the appropriate 8 9 congressional committees a report on whether and how the 10 People's Republic of China, including the Government of 11 the People's Republic of China, the Chinese Communist 12 Party, any Chinese state-owned enterprise, and any other Chinese entity, has provided support to the Russian Fed-13 eration with respect to its unprovoked invasion of and full-14 scale war against Ukraine. 15

(b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report required by subsection (a) shall include a discussion of the
People's Republic of China support to the Russian Federation with respect to—

(1) helping the Government of Russia or Rus sian entities evade or circumvent United States
 sanctions or multilateral sanctions and export con trols;

5 (2) deliberately inhibiting onsite United States
6 Government export control end-use checks, including
7 interviews and investigations, in China;

8 (3) providing Russia with any technology, in9 cluding semiconductors classified as EAR99, that
10 supports Russian intelligence or military capabilities;

(4) establishing economic or financial arrangements that will have the effect of alleviating the impact of United States sanctions or multilateral sanctions;

15 (5) furthering Russia's disinformation and16 propaganda efforts;

17 (6) coordinating to hinder the response of mul-18 tilateral organizations, including the United Nations, 19 to provide assistance to the people or Government of 20 Ukraine, to condemn Russia's war, to hold Russia 21 accountable for the invasion and its prosecution of 22 the war, or to hold those complicit accountable; and 23 (7)providing any material, technical, -or 24 logistical support, including to Russian military or 3

intelligence agencies and state-owned or state-linked
 enterprises.

3 (c) FORM.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The report required by sub5 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form
6 and published on the Department of State's publicly
7 available website.

8 (2) EXCEPTION.—If the Secretary, in consulta-9 tion with the Director of National Intelligence, cer-10 tifies to the appropriate congressional committees 11 that the Secretary is unable to include an element 12 required under paragraphs (1) through (7) of sub-13 section (b) in an unclassified manner, the Secretary 14 shall provide in unclassified form an affirmative or 15 negative determination for each element required 16 under subsections (b)(1)-(7) whether the People's 17 Republic of China is supporting the Russian Federa-18 tion in that manner and concurrently provide the 19 discussion of that element to the committees at the 20 lowest possible classification level, consistent with 21 the protection of sources and methods.

(d) SUNSET.—The requirement to submit the report
required by subsection (a) shall terminate on the earlier
of—

3	(2) the date that is 2 years after the date of the

5	(e) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
6	FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
7	sional committees" means—
8	(1) the congressional defense committees;
9	(2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
10	Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the
11	House of Representatives; and
12	(3) the Committee on Foreign Relations, the
13	Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Af-
14	fairs, and the Select Committee on Intelligence of
15	the Senate.
