5	(a) In General.—Except as provided by subsection
6	(c), an action described in subsection (b) shall be—
7	(1) treated as a covered project, as defined in
8	section 41001(6) of the Fixing America's Surface
9	Transportation Act (42 U.S.C. 4370m(6)), without
10	regard to the requirements of that section; and
11	(2) included in the Permitting Dashboard main-
12	tained pursuant to section 41003(b) of that Act (42
13	U.S.C. 4370m-2(b)).
14	(b) ACTIONS DESCRIBED.—An action described in
15	this subsection is an action taken by the Secretary of De-
16	fense pursuant to Presidential Determination 2022–11
17	(87 Fed. Reg. 19775; relating to certain actions under
18	section 303 of the Defense Production Act of 1950) to
19	create, maintain, protect, expand, or restore sustainable

1	and responsible domestic production capabilities for stra-
2	tegic and critical materials through—
3	(1) supporting feasibility studies for mature
4	mining, beneficiation, and value-added processing
5	projects;
6	(2) by-product and co-product production at ex-
7	isting mining, mine waste reclamation, and other in-
8	dustrial facilities;
9	(3) modernization of mining, beneficiation, and
10	value-added processing to increase productivity, envi-
11	ronmental sustainability, and workforce safety; or
12	(4) any other activity authorized under section
13	303(a)(1) of the Defense Production Act of 1950
14	(50 U.S.C. 4533(a)(1)).
15	(c) Exception.—An action described in subsection
16	(b) may not be treated as a covered project or be included
17	in the Permitting Dashboard under subsection (a) if the
18	project sponsor (as defined in section 41001(18) of the
19	Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (42 U.S.C.
20	4370m(18))) requests that the action not be treated as
21	a covered project.
