2	(a) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the date
3	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State, in

5	States Trade Representative, shall submit to the appro-
6	priate congressional committees a report containing the
7	results of a study to increase energy cooperation between
8	the United States and India, that also includes a descrip-
9	tion of—
10	(1) opportunities for the United States to re-
11	place Indian dependence on Russian energy with
12	United States energy resources;
13	(2) opportunities for the sharing of technology
14	to foster cleaner processing of fossil fuels, including
15	clean coal technology;
16	(3) potential benefits to United States national
17	security resulting from increased energy cooperation
18	between the United States and India:

1	(4) potential benefits to the United States econ-
2	omy resulting from increased energy cooperation be-
3	tween the United States and India; and
4	(5) potential non-governmental partners, includ-
5	ing universities and institutions of higher education,
6	that could help assist in research and development
7	associated with increased energy cooperation be-
8	tween the United States and India
9	(b) Appropriate Congressional Committees
10	Defined.—In this section the term, "appropriate con-
11	gressional committees" means
12	(1) the Committee on Foreign Relations, Com-
13	mittee on Energy and Natural Resources, and Com-
14	mittee on Commerce of the Senate; and
15	(2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs, Com-
16	mittee on Energy and Commerce, and Committee on
17	Ways and Means of the House of Representatives.
