4	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that House Report
5	118–301 accompanying the National Defense Authoriza-
6	tion Act for Fiscal Year 2024 (Public Law 118–31) di-
7	rected the Secretary of the Army, in coordination with the
8	Commanding General, Army Materiel Command and the
9	Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics,
10	and Technology to provide a briefing on the costs and esti-
11	mated funding profile as it relates to the organic industrial
12	base modernization strategy, and facility efforts required
13	to support opportunities for organic industrial base aug-
14	mentation at Blue Grass Army Depot in Kentucky.
15	(b) Cost-benefit Analysis.—The Secretary of the
16	Army, in coordination with the Commanding General of
17	the Army Materiel Command and the Assistant Secretary
18	of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics, and Technology,

- 2 costs, benefits, and feasibility of insourcing to the organic

- 6 (c) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
- 7 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
- 8 shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the

- 10 results of the cost-benefit analysis conducted under sub-
- 11 section (b).
