Page 27, after line 17, insert the following new paragraph:

(6) ensure that the total annual compensation

2 paid, promised, or provided to any athletics depart-3 ment employee does not exceed 10 times the average 4 cost of attendance, for the most recent academic 5 year, for the top member institutions used to cal-6 culate the pool limit established under section 7(a) 7 for the interstate intercollegiate athletic association 8 in which such institution is a member, provided 9 that— 10 (A) any payment to terminate, buy out, or 11 settle an employment agreement with an ath-12 letics department employee shall be treated as 13 compensation for purposes of this paragraph in

1	the year paid, and may not cause the cap in
2	this paragraph to be exceeded;
3	(B) written employment agreements exe-
4	cuted—
5	(i) before the date of enactment of
6	this Act may continue for their remaining
7	original term (excluding extensions or re-
8	newals), provided that—
9	(I) the agreement and scheduled
10	payments are disclosed; and
11	(II) no amendment to the agree-
12	ment increases compensation above
13	amounts stated in the agreement as of
14	the date of enactment of this Act; and
15	(ii) on or after the date of enactment
16	of this Act shall comply with this para-
17	graph;
18	(C) the term "total annual compensation"
19	means wages, salaries, stipends, allowances, in-
20	centive or performance bonuses, signing or re-
21	tention bonuses, deferred compensation, em-
22	ployer retirement contributions above standard
23	plan matches, severance, buyouts, cancellation
24	or mitigation payments, in-kind compensation,
25	appearance fees, debt servicing, debt relief, and

1	any other compensation paid by or through a
2	related organization (including a foundation,
3	booster organization, media arm, or affiliate) or
4	a third party under an arrangement to perform
5	services for the institution; and
6	(D) the term "athletics department em-
7	ployee" means any employee of the institution
8	(or of a related organization acting for the in-
9	stitution) whose primary duties relate to inter-
10	collegiate athletics, including head and assistant
11	coaches, the director of athletics, associate or
12	assistant athletic directors, and senior athletics
13	administrators.
