

**AMENDMENT TO DIVISION C OF THE  
CONSOLIDATED APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2026  
OFFERED BY MRS. BEATTY OF OHIO**

At the end of division C (before the short title), insert the following:

1        SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. (a) Not later than 180 days after the date  
2 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall develop training curricula or identify effective  
3 existing training curricula for U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement officers and for mental health professionals regarding—

7            (1) de-escalation tactics and alternatives to use  
8 of force;

9            (2) safely responding to an individual experiencing a mental or behavioral health or suicidal crisis or an individual with a disability, including techniques and strategies that are designed to protect  
10 the safety of that individual, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement officers, mental health professionals, and the public;

16            (3) successfully participating on a crisis intervention team; and

1           (4) making referrals to community-based men-  
2           tal and behavioral health services and support, hous-  
3           ing assistance programs, public benefits programs,  
4           the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, and other  
5           services.

6           (b) The training curricula developed or identified  
7           under subsection (a) shall include—

8           (1) scenario-based exercises;

9           (2) pre-training and post-training tests to as-  
10          sess relevant knowledge and skills covered in the  
11          training curricula; and

12          (3) follow-up evaluative assessments to deter-  
13          mine the degree to which participants in the training  
14          apply, in their jobs, the knowledge and skills gained  
15          in the training.
