

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13
OFFERED BY MR. BERA OF CALIFORNIA

Page 923, line 21, insert “as well as additional options to support Taiwan’s development and implementation of a territorial defense force concept, taking into consideration the policy objectives described in subsection (b)” before the period.

Page 924, after line 18, insert the following:

1 (4) A review of additional options to provide ad-
2 ditional technical advice, training, or institution
3 building to support the objectives described in sub-
4 section (b), and any other appropriate policy objec-
5 tives.

6 (5) An assessment of the policy opportunities
7 and challenges associated with the options provided
8 pursuant to this subsection.

9 (6) An assessment of any statutory or adminis-
10 trative barriers to the options provided pursuant to
11 this subsection.

12 (7) A determination of the most appropriate en-
13 tities within the Department of Defense and in the

1 Taiwan Reserve Command to lead the options pro-
2 vided pursuant to this subsection.

3 (8) An evaluation of the capacity of appropriate
4 entities in the Department of Defense to support the
5 options provided pursuant to this subsection and of
6 the Taiwan Reserve Command to absorb the options
7 provided pursuant to this subsection.

8 (9) A description of additional resources and
9 authorities that may be required to execute any of
10 the options provided pursuant to this subsection.

Page 924, after line 20, insert the following:

11 (b) POLICY OBJECTIVES.—The matters required by
12 paragraphs (4) through (9) of subsection (a) shall take
13 into consideration the following policy objectives:

14 (1) Advancing Taiwan Reserve's Command abil-
15 ity to recruit, train, and equip its forces, including
16 its ability to require and provide regular individual
17 and collective training to all reserve forces.

18 (2) Enhancing Taiwan's ability to respond to
19 humanitarian disasters.

20 (3) Strengthening Taiwan's ability to defend
21 against, and resist if necessary, Chinese military ag-
22 gression.
