## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-57

## OFFERED BY MR. BERA OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle B of title III add the following:

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_. BIOLOGICAL THREATS REPORT.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense,
in coordination with the Secretary of State, shall submit
to the appropriate congressional committees a report on
efforts to prevent, detect, and respond to biological
threats, including through cooperation with bilateral and
multilateral partners.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report shall include the fol-10 lowing:

(1) A description of actions taken by the Department of Defense to improve proliferation prevention regarding, detection of, and response to biological threats of natural, accidental, or deliberate origin, including the following:

(B) Organizational chart describing those responsible in each Department for coordinating these activities, in accordance with the report required by section 745 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public Law 116–92).

9 (C) A description of efforts to integrate 10 Department of Defense infectious disease re-11 search, cooperative threat reduction programs, 12 and other activities designed to protect Depart-13 ment of Defense personnel against infectious 14 disease threats.

15 (2) Programs and policies to address the threat of accidental or deliberate misuse of emerging bio-16 17 logical technologies, including synthetic biology, in-18 cluding Cooperative Threat Reduction, efforts to co-19 operate with other partners to establish international 20 norms and standards, consideration of new technologies in the Biological Threat Reduction Pro-21 22 gram, and efforts to develop countermeasures.

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
