

**AMENDMENT RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 115-23**

**OFFERED BY MR. BEYER OF VIRGINIA**

At the end of subtitle E of title X, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 10 \_\_\_\_ . REPORT ON EFFECT ON DEPARTMENT OF DE-**  
2 **FENSE OPERATIONS IN NATIONAL CAPITAL**  
3 **REGION OF CLOSURE OF ARLINGTON MEMO-**  
4 **RIAL BRIDGE.**

5 (a) FINDING.—Congress finds that, according to the  
6 Federal Highway Administration, without a complete  
7 overhaul, Arlington Memorial Bridge will be closed to vehi-  
8 cle traffic by 2021.

9 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the date  
10 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense  
11 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-  
12 port on a partial or complete shutdown of Arlington Me-  
13 morial Bridge.

14 (c) ELEMENTS.—The report under subsection (b)  
15 shall—

16 (1) address the impact of a partial or complete  
17 shutdown of Arlington Memorial Bridge on the De-  
18 partment of Defense, including with respect to—

1 (A) the continuity of government oper-  
2 ations;

3 (B) the access and use of emergency evac-  
4 uation plans of the District of Columbia;

5 (C) employees of the Department; and

6 (D) the Pentagon and other installations  
7 of the Department in the National Capital Re-  
8 gion (as defined in section 2674(f) of title 10,  
9 United States Code); and

10 (2) include the contingency plans and associ-  
11 ated costs of the Department in the event of a par-  
12 tial or complete shutdown of Arlington Memorial  
13 Bridge.

14 (d) COORDINATION WITH FEDERAL, STATE, AND  
15 LOCAL ENTITIES.—In preparing the report under sub-  
16 section (b), the Secretary of Defense may work in conjunc-  
17 tion with, and coordinate with, the States, units of local  
18 government, other Federal departments and agencies, and  
19 other entities that would be affected by a partial or com-  
20 plete shutdown of Arlington Memorial Bridge.
