

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8
OFFERED BY MR. BEYER OF VIRGINIA

Page 182, line 6, strike “Chapter 157” and insert
“(a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 157”.

Page 183, line 13, strike “(d)” and insert “(f)”.

Page 183, after line 12, insert the following new
subsections:

1 “(d) RISK MITIGATION.—The Secretary of Defense
2 shall require any aircraft of the Department of Defense
3 that operates near a commercial airport be equipped with
4 position broadcast technology and shall direct the develop-
5 ment of standard operating procedures that maximize the
6 use of such technology.

7 “(e) COORDINATION WITH FEDERAL AVIATION AD-
8 MINISTRATION.—The Secretary of Defense shall develop
9 a program for sharing aviation safety data for aircraft of
10 the Department of Defense, including data concerning
11 near misses and mishaps, with the Administrator of the
12 Federal Aviation Administration.”.

Page 183, after line 22, insert the following new
subsection:

1 (b) REPORTS ON NEAR MISSES.—

2 (1) INITIAL REPORT.—Not later than 180 days
3 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
4 retary of Defense shall submit to the Committees on
5 Armed Services of the House of Representatives and
6 the Senate a report on the number of near misses
7 that aircraft of the Department of Defense have had
8 with commercial aircraft during the 10-year period
9 preceding such date.

10 (2) ANNUAL REPORT.—Not later than one year
11 after the date of the enactment of this Act, and an-
12 nually thereafter through 2030, the Secretary shall
13 submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the
14 House of Representatives and the Senate a report on
15 the number of near misses that aircraft of the De-
16 partment have had with commercial aircraft during
17 the previous fiscal year.

18 (3) ELEMENTS.—Each report under this sub-
19 section shall include, with respect to each near miss
20 covered under the report, the following:

21 (A) The date, time, and location of the
22 near miss.

23 (B) A description of any aircraft involved
24 in the near miss.

1 (C) Any changes to protocols, standard op-
2 erating procedures, or policy, as appropriate,
3 that were made based on the near miss.

4 (4) FORM OF REPORT.—Each report under this
5 subsection shall be submitted in unclassified form,
6 but may include a classified annex.
