10 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
11 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall
12 submit to the Committee on Transportation and Infra-
13 structure and the Committee on Energy and Commerce
14 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
15 Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions and the Com-
16 mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the
17 Senate a report on the results of the study conducted
18 under subsection (a).
