At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

- SEC. 17 . COMPENSATORY PRODUCTION INCREASE 2 PLAN. 3 Section 161 of the Energy Policy and Conservation 4 Act (42 U.S.C. 6241) is amended by adding at the end 5 the following new subsection: 6 "(k) Plan.— 7 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Except in the case of a se-8 vere energy supply interruption described in sub-9 section (d), the Secretary may not execute the first 10 drawdown of petroleum products in the Reserve after the date of enactment of this subsection, whether through sale, exchange, or loan, until the
- after the date of enactment of this subsection,
 whether through sale, exchange, or loan, until the
 Secretary has developed and implemented a plan to
 increase the percentage of Federal lands (including
 submerged lands of the Outer Continental Shelf)
- under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of Agriculture, the Secretary of Energy, the Secretary of
- the Interior, or the Secretary of Defense leased for

1	oil and gas production by the same percentage as
2	the percentage of petroleum in the Strategic Petro-
3	leum Reserve that is to be drawn down in that first
4	and subsequent drawdowns, subject to the limitation
5	under paragraph (2).
6	"(2) Limitation.—The plan required by para-
7	graph (1) shall not provide for a total increase in
8	the percentage of Federal lands described in para-
9	graph (1) leased for oil and gas production in excess
10	of 10 percent.
11	"(3) Consultation.—The Secretary shall pre-
12	pare the plan required by paragraph (1) in consulta-
13	tion with the Secretary of Agriculture, the Secretary
14	of the Interior, and the Secretary of Defense.".
