

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 6119
OFFERED BY MR. BIGGS OF ARIZONA

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . NULLIFICATION OF CERTAIN EXECUTIVE OR-**
2 **DERS.**

3 (a) SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR FEDERAL CONTRAC-
4 TORS.—Executive Order 14042 (86 Fed. Reg. 50985, re-
5 lating to ensuring adequate COVID–19 safety protocols
6 for Federal contractors) shall have no force or effect.

7 (b) COVID–19 VACCINE REQUIREMENT.—Executive
8 Order 14043 (86 Fed. Reg. 50989, relating to requiring
9 COVID–19 vaccination for Federal employees) shall have
10 no force or effect.

11 **SEC. ____ . PROHIBITION OF RULES MANDATING VACCINA-**
12 **TION.**

13 The Secretary of Labor may not issue any rule re-
14 quiring employers to mandate vaccination of employees
15 against COVID–19 or requiring testing of employees who
16 are unvaccinated against COVID–19.

17 **SEC. ____ . PROHIBITION ON MEDICARE AND MEDICAID**
18 **COVID–19 VACCINATION MANDATES.**

19 Notwithstanding any provision of title XI, XVIII, or
20 XIX of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1301 et seq.,

1 1395 et seq., 1396 et seq.), the Secretary of Health and
2 Human Services may not require a health care provider,
3 as a condition of participation in the Medicare or Medicaid
4 program, to mandate vaccination of employees against
5 COVID-19 or require testing of employees who are
6 unvaccinated against COVID-19, and may not otherwise
7 penalize such a provider for such provider's failure to so
8 mandate such vaccination or so require such testing.
