

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**

**57**

**OFFERED BY MR. BIGGS OF ARIZONA**

At the end of subtitle E of title XII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 12\_\_\_ . REPORT ON ANNUAL DEFENSE SPENDING BY**  
2 **ALLY AND PARTNER COUNTRIES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 6 months after the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense  
5 shall submit to the congressional defense committees, the  
6 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representa-  
7 tives, and the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Sen-  
8 ate a report that includes a description of—

9 (1) the annual defense spending of each mutual  
10 defense treaty ally and major non-NATO ally, in-  
11 cluding the nominal budget figure and the share of  
12 such spending as a percentage of the gross domestic  
13 product of the ally, for the fiscal year immediately  
14 preceding the fiscal year in which the report is sub-  
15 mitted;

16 (2) the activities of each such ally in contrib-  
17 uting to military or stability operations in which the  
18 Armed Forces participate;

1           (3) any limitations that each such ally places on  
2           the use of the Armed Forces of such ally for such  
3           military or stability operations; and

4           (4) any actions undertaken by the United  
5           States or other countries to minimize or modify such  
6           limitations.

7           (b) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)  
8           shall be submitted in unclassified form but may contain  
9           a classified annex.

10          (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

11           (1) MUTUAL DEFENSE TREATY ALLY.—The  
12           term “mutual defense treaty ally” means a country  
13           that is a party to a treaty of mutual defense with  
14           the United States.

15           (2) MAJOR NON-NATO ALLY.—The term “major  
16           non-NATO ally” means a country so designated pur-  
17           suant to section 2350a of title 10, United States  
18           Code, or section 517 of the Foreign Assistance Act  
19           of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2321k).
