## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 11570

## OFFERED BY MR. BILIRAKIS OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle D of title XVI, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 16 EXTENDED NUCLEAR DETERRENCE POSTURE
2	IN SUPPORT OF NATO.
3	(a) STATEMENT OF POLICY.—It is the policy of the
4	United States to—
5	(1) maintain a modernized nuclear capability
6	that provides for effective deterrence against peer,
7	near-peer, and regional adversaries, consistent with
8	the national security interests of the United States;
9	(2) extend the nuclear deterrent of the United
10	States to deter aggression against close allies of the
11	United States, including members of the North At-
12	lantic Treaty Organization (NATO); and
13	(3) ensure the highest levels of reliability, credi-
14	bility, safety, and security for all nuclear weapons of
15	the United States, including those forward-deployed
16	in support of NATO.
17	(b) Briefing.—Not later than 90 days after the date
18	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense

- 1 shall provide to the Committees on Armed Services of the
- 2 House of Representatives and the Senate, and to any
- 3 other congressional defense committee upon request, a
- 4 briefing regarding the current status of, and future plans
- 5 for, the extended nuclear deterrence posture of the United
- 6 States in support of NATO.
