OFFERED BY MR. BISHOP OF GEORGIA

Add at the end of title IV add the following:

1 **SEC. 4___ . MILITARY COMMISSARY FRESH FRUITS AND**
2 **VEGETABLE DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM.**

3 Section 4405 of the Food, Conservation, and Energy
4 Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 7517) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (e)(3)(B)(ii)(IV), by striking
6 “(e)(2)(B)(iii)” and inserting “(f)(2)(B)(iii)”;

7 (2) in subsection (d)—

8 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “(b) or
9 (c)” and inserting “(b), (c), or (d)”;

10 (B) in each of paragraphs (2) through (4),
11 by striking “(b) and (c)” and inserting “(b),
12 (c), and (d)”;

13 (3) in subsection (f)—

14 (A) in paragraph (2)(G), by inserting “,
15 except that none of the funds may be used to
16 carry out subsection (d)” before the period; and

17 (B) in paragraph (3)(C), by striking “(e)”
18 and inserting “(f)”;

1 (4) by redesignating subsections (d) through (f)
2 as subsections (e) through (g), respectively, and in-
3 serting after subsection (c) the following:

4 “(d) MILITARY COMMISSARY FRESH FRUITS AND
5 VEGETABLE DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM.—

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in coopera-
7 tion with the Secretary of Defense, shall establish a
8 demonstration program in not fewer than 5 military
9 commissaries to conduct 5-year projects that dem-
10 onstrate the effect on the diets of military families
11 that receive benefits under the supplemental nutri-
12 tion assistance program of incentivizing the pur-
13 chase of fresh fruits and vegetables.

14 “(2) INCENTIVE TREATED AS A SNAP BEN-
15 EFIT.—

16 “(A) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of all
17 Federal law, the value of any incentive provided
18 under a project conducted pursuant to para-
19 graph (1) shall be considered a benefit provided
20 under the supplemental nutrition assistance
21 program.

22 “(B) NO EFFECT ON OTHER SNAP BENE-
23 FITS.—The value of any incentive provided
24 under a project conducted pursuant to para-
25 graph (1) shall not be taken into account in de-

1 termining eligibility for, or the amount of, any
2 other benefit provided under the supplemental
3 nutrition assistance program.

4 “(3) EVALUATION.—The Secretary shall con-
5 tract with an appropriate entity, as determined by
6 the Secretary, to evaluate the impact of the dem-
7 onstration program on the military families served
8 by the commissaries that are part of the demonstra-
9 tion program.

10 “(4) LIMITATIONS ON AUTHORIZATION OF AP-
11 PROPRIATIONS.—There is authorized to be appro-
12 priated to carry out this subsection not more than
13 \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2024 through
14 2028.”.
