

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4505, AS REPORTED (CJS
APPROPRIATIONS)
OFFERED BY MR. BLUMENAUER OF OREGON**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1 SEC. _____. None of the funds made available by this
2 Act to the Department of Justice may be used, with re-
3 spect to any of the States of Alabama, Alaska, Arizona,
4 Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware,
5 Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas,
6 Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts,
7 Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Ne-
8 braska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mex-
9 ico, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio,
10 Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South
11 Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah,
12 Vermont, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, Wisconsin,
13 and Wyoming, or with respect to the District of Columbia,
14 the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands,
15 Guam, Puerto Rico, or the United States Virgin Islands,
16 to prevent any of them from implementing their own laws
17 that authorize the use, distribution, possession, or cultiva-
18 tion of marijuana.

1 SEC. _____. None of the funds made available by this
2 Act to the Department of Justice may be used to prevent
3 any Indian tribe (as such term is defined in section 4 of
4 the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance
5 Act (25 U.S.C. 5304)) from enacting or implementing
6 tribal laws that authorize the use, distribution, possession,
7 or cultivation of marijuana.
