OFFERED BY MR. BLUMENAUER OF OREGON

Page 609, strike lines 3 through 12 and insert the following:

1 “(1) protect the interests of the United States
2 in space;

3 “(2) deter aggression in, from, and to space;

4 “(3) conduct space operations; and

5 “(4) monitor, assess, report on, and plan for
6 the impacts of climate change on United States na-
7 tional security priorities including by—

8 “(A) developing recommendations for re-
9 quirements for climate and social science data
10 and intelligence analyses, as appropriate, that
11 support national security interests;

12 “(B) cataloging climate science data, intel-
13 ligence analyses, and other products and pro-
14 grams that support or should be considered in
15 the development of national security doctrine,
16 policy, and plans;

17 “(C) facilitating the production and ex-
18 change of climate data and information with

1 relevant stakeholders, including the United
2 States Intelligence Community, and private sec-
3 tor partners, as appropriate;

4 “(D) producing, as appropriate, and mak-
5 ing available science-informed intelligence as-
6 sessments to agencies having responsibilities in
7 the development of national security doctrine,
8 policies, and plans in order to identify climate
9 change-related impacts and prioritize actions
10 related thereto; and

11 “(E) developing recommendations for the
12 Department of Defense to help ensure that the
13 work of the United States Military is better in-
14 formed by relevant climate change-related anal-
15 yses.”.

Page 610, line 5, strike “(f)” and insert “(e)”.
