At the end of division E (before the short title), insert the following:

1	SEC (a) No Federal funds appropriated or
2	otherwise made available to the Department of Homeland
3	Security for any fiscal year may be made available for the
4	salary or expenses of the following:
5	(1) Any Federal employee responding, pursuant
6	to any Federal authority, to a mass gathering in any
7	area under the jurisdiction of a State, local, tribal,
8	or territorial government—
9	(A) who is not—
10	(i) an employee of the United States
11	Secret Service acting in protection of a
12	protectee; or
13	(ii) subject to subsection (b), an em-
14	ployee, including any contract employee, of
15	the Federal Protective Service acting in
16	routine protection of Federal property; or
17	(B) subject to subsection (b), if—

(i) such response is not pursuant to a
written request submitted to the Secretary
of Homeland Security by the head of such
government; or
(ii) the head of such government sub-
mits to the Secretary of Homeland Secu-
rity a withdrawal of such written request.
(2) Any employee of the Department of Home-
land Security carrying out activities described in the
Office of Intelligence and Analysis legal guidance en-
titled "Job Aid: DHS Office of Intelligence & Anal-
ysis (I&A) Activities in Furtherance of Protecting
American Monuments, Memorials, Statues, and
Combatting Recent Criminal Violence".
(b) In addition to the prohibition under subsection
(a), no Federal funds appropriated or otherwise made
available to the Department of Homeland Security for any
fiscal year may be made available for the salary or ex-
penses of a Federal employee described in subparagraph
(A)(ii) of subsection $(a)(1)$ or a Federal employee acting
pursuant to a written request described in subparagraph
(B)(i) of subsection (a)(1) unless such employee we ars a
uniform that—

(1) clearly identifies the Federal agency affiliation ofthe employee; and

(2) if the employee is acting in a civilian capacity,
is not similar to a combat-style uniform worn by members
of the United States Armed Forces.
