

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 467, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. BLUNT ROCHESTER OF
DELAWARE**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 7. GAO REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL MAIL AND CARGO**
2 **SCREENING.**

3 Not later than one year after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
5 shall submit to the Congress a report reviewing the impact
6 of High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas program on il-
7 licit fentanyl and fentanyl-related substances imported
8 through international mail and cargo, including discussion
9 of the following:

10 (1) The volume of fentanyl and fentanyl-related
11 substances being imported into the country by
12 means of international mail and cargo.

13 (2) The potential impact of increased screening
14 for illicit fentanyl and fentanyl-related substances
15 on—

16 (A) deterring drug trafficking in the
17 United States;

18 (B) interdicting fentanyl and fentanyl-re-
19 lated substances that were manufactured out-

1 side of the United States and intended, or at-
2 tempted, to be imported into the United States;

3 (C) the number of Federal criminal pros-
4 ecutions based on the manufacture, distribu-
5 tion, or possession of fentanyl or fentanyl-re-
6 lated substances, disaggregated by demographic
7 data, including sex, race, and ethnicity, of the
8 offender;

9 (D) the charges brought in such prosecu-
10 tions;

11 (E) the impacts of prosecutions on reduc-
12 ing demand and availability to users; and

13 (F) the development of new fentanyl-re-
14 lated substances.

15 (3) The need for non-invasive technology in
16 screening for fentanyl and fentanyl-related sub-
17 stances, taking into account the findings pursuant to
18 paragraphs (1) and (2).
