

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 467, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. BLUNT ROCHESTER OF
DELAWARE**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. 7. OPIOID TREATMENT EDUCATION.

2 Part D of title V of the Public Health Service Act
3 (42 U.S.C. 290dd et seq.) is amended by adding at the
4 end the following:

5 “SEC. 553. OPIOID TREATMENT EDUCATION.

6 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall award
7 grants to States and local governmental entities to provide
8 education to stakeholders, including health care providers,
9 criminal justice professionals, and substance use disorder
10 treatment personnel, on the current state of research on
11 treatment for opioid use disorder, including—

12 “(1) the use of opioid agonists or partial
13 agonists; and

14 “(2) the potential benefits of the use of opioid
15 agonists or partial agonists for affected individuals.

16 “(b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the
17 date of enactment of the HALT Fentanyl Act, the Sec-
18 retary shall submit a report to the Committee on Energy
19 and Commerce of the House of Representatives and the

1 Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of
2 the Senate, including the following data:

3 “(1) The number of people reached by edu-
4 cational materials funded pursuant to this section.

5 “(2) The geographic areas where people re-
6 ceived such educational materials.

7 “(3) The remaining populations and areas tar-
8 geted for awareness of educational materials, includ-
9 ing the characteristics of such populations and areas
10 such as the type of stakeholder and geographic area.

11 “(4) The select outcomes of education funded
12 pursuant to this section as determined by the Sec-
13 retary.”.
