

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 467, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. BLUNT ROCHESTER OF
DELAWARE**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 7. INCREASING ACCESS TO MEDICATION FOR OPIOID**
2 **OVERDOSE REVERSAL.**

3 (a) TRANSACTIONS.—Section 581(24)(B) of the Fed-
4 eral Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C.
5 360eee(24)(B)) is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating clauses (xvii) and (xviii) as
7 clauses (xviii) and (xix), respectively; and

8 (2) by inserting after clause (xvi) the following:

9 “(xvii) the distribution of an opioid
10 antagonist indicated for emergency treat-
11 ment of opioid overdose, such as naloxone,
12 by or to an overdose prevention, syringe
13 services program, or other harm reduction
14 service;”.

15 (b) WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTION.—Section 503(e)(4)
16 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C.
17 353(e)(4)) is amended—

18 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (R) and (S)
19 as subparagraphs (S) and (T), respectively; and

1 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (Q) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(R) the distribution of an opioid antago-
4 nist indicated for emergency treatment of opioid
5 overdose, such as naloxone, by or to an over-
6 dose prevention, syringe services program, or
7 other harm reduction service;”.
