

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-2
OFFERED BY MRS. BOEBERT OF COLORADO

At the end of the bill, add the following new title:

1 **TITLE IX—GRAZING RIGHTS AND**
2 **OTHER PROTECTIONS**

3 **SEC. 901. MORATORIUMS.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the
5 Secretary concerned shall not declare a moratorium or
6 temporarily suspended any grazing permit or lease.

7 **SEC. 902. CURRENT LEASES AND PERMITS.**

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the
9 Secretary concerned shall continue to issue grazing per-
10 mits and leases on federal lands on which a grazing permit
11 or lease were issued before the date of enactment of this
12 Act.

13 **SEC. 903. WILDERNESS DESIGNATIONS AND GRAZING.**

14 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, any
15 wilderness or potential wilderness designated under this
16 Act shall not alter any grazing permit or lease.

17 **SEC. 904. FIRE MANAGEMENT AND RELATED ACTIVITIES.**

18 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the
19 Secretary may authorize grazing permittees on federal

1 lands designated as a wilderness area or potential wilder-
2 ness area under this Act to control fire, carry out haz-
3 ardous fuel and vegetation management activities, manage
4 invasive species or accomplish other ecological objectives.

5 **SEC. 905. MOTORIZED VEHICLE USE.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, mo-
7 torized vehicles are permitted on federal lands designated
8 as a wilderness area or potential wilderness area under
9 this Act to control fire, carry out hazardous fuel and vege-
10 tation management activities, manage invasive species or
11 accomplish other ecological objectives, build fence, main-
12 tain existing infrastructure, accomplish other grazing
13 maintenance objectives, and construct or rehabilitate
14 range improvements as are necessary to obtain appro-
15 priate livestock management objectives (including habitat,
16 wildlife and watershed restoration).
