At the end of subtitle C of title V, insert the following:

1	SEC. 5 CERTAIN PROTECTIONS FOR MEMBERS WHO
2	REFUSE TO RECEIVE A VACCINATION
3	AGAINST COVID-19.
4	(a) Prohibitions.—
5	(1) Federal funds for vaccine man-
6	DATE.—No Federal funds may be used to require a
7	member of the Armed Forces to receive a vaccina-
8	tion against COVID-19.
9	(2) Adverse action.—No member of the
10	Armed Forces may be subject to adverse action sole-
11	ly on the basis of the refusal of such member to re-
12	ceive a vaccination against COVID-19.
13	(b) Reinstatement.—At the request of a covered
14	individual, the Secretary concerned shall—
15	(1) reinstate the covered individual as a mem-
16	ber of the Armed Force concerned, in the same rank

1	and grade the covered individual held at the time of
2	separation from the Armed Force concerned;
3	(2) expunge from the military service record of
4	the covered individual any reference to adverse ac-
5	tion against the covered individual solely on the
6	basis of the refusal of the covered individual to re-
7	ceive a vaccination against COVID-19; and
8	(3) include, in the computation of the retired or
9	retainer pay of such covered individual, the period
10	between the involuntary separation and the rein-
11	statement, under paragraph (2), of the covered indi-
12	vidual.
13	(c) Back Pay and Benefits.—A covered individual
14	who makes a request under subsection (b) shall be entitled
15	to back pay and benefits for the period between such sepa-
16	ration and reinstatement of the covered individual.
17	(d) Definitions.—In this section:
18	(1) The term "adverse action" includes involun-
19	tary separation, demotion, and discipline.
20	(2) The term "covered individual" means an in-
21	dividual who was involuntarily separated from an
22	Armed Force solely on the basis of the refusal of
23	such individual to receive a vaccination against
24	COVID-19.

(3) The term "Secretary concerned" has the
 meaning given such term in section 101 of title 10,
 United States Code.
