

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE**

**OFFERED BY MRS. BOEBERT OF COLORADO**

At the end of title I of division B, insert the following:

**1 SEC. 117. TRANSPARENCY AND REPORTING.**

2 (a) INFORMATION INCLUDED IN MONTHLY BILLING  
3 TO POWER CUSTOMERS.—The Administrators of each of  
4 the Bonneville Power Administration, the Western Area  
5 Power Administration, the Southwestern Power Adminis-  
6 tration, and the Southeastern Power Administration shall  
7 include in monthly billings sent to each of their power cus-  
8 tomers information estimating and reporting the costs of  
9 the customer's share of the direct and indirect costs in-  
10 curred by the administration related to compliance with  
11 any Federal environmental laws impacting the conserva-  
12 tion of fish and wildlife considered by the Administrator  
13 concerned to be relevant.

14 (b) DIRECT COSTS.—Direct costs reported under this  
15 subsection shall include Federal agency obligations related  
16 to costs of studies; capital, operation, maintenance, and  
17 replacement costs; and staffing costs.

1 (c) INDIRECT COSTS.—Indirect costs reported under  
2 this subsection shall include foregone generation and re-  
3 placement power costs, including the net costs of any  
4 transmission.

5 (d) COORDINATION.—The Commissioner of the Bu-  
6 reau of Reclamation and the head of any other affected  
7 Federal agency shall assist the Administrators with the  
8 identification of the costs.

9 (e) REPORT.—No later than January 30 of each  
10 year, each of the Administrators referred to in subsection  
11 (a), in coordination with the Bureau of Reclamation and  
12 other affected Federal agencies, shall provide an annual  
13 report to the appropriate committees of the House of Rep-  
14 resentatives and the Senate estimating the total of the di-  
15 rect and indirect costs incurred by the administration re-  
16 lated to compliance with any Federal environmental laws  
17 impacting the conservation of fish and wildlife, the sources  
18 of replacement power, and costs related to integrating  
19 wind energy resources considered by the Administrator  
20 concerned, at that Administrator's sole discretion after  
21 consultation with consumers, to be relevant.
