At the end of subtitle B of title III, add the following new section:

5 (a) REVIEW REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days of 6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary 7 of Defense shall complete a review of mutual support 8 agreements entered into with non-Department of Defense 9 entities (including State and local entities) that involve 10 fire suppression activities in support of missions of the De-11 partment.

(b) MATTERS.—The review under subsection (a) shall
assess, with respect to the agreements specified in such
subsection, the following:

(1) The preventative maintenance guidelines
specified in such agreements for fire trucks and fire
suppression systems, to mitigate the risk of equip-

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ment failure that may result in a spill of aqueous
 film-forming foam (in this section referred to as
 "AFFF").

4 (2) Any requirements specified in such agree-5 ments for the use of personal protective equipment 6 by personnel when conducting a material transfer or 7 maintenance activity pursuant to the agreement that 8 may result in a spill of AFFF, or when conducting 9 remediation activities for such a spill, including re-10 quirements for side-shield safety glasses, latex 11 gloves, and respiratory protection equipment.

(3) The methods by which the Secretary, or the
non-Department entity with which the Secretary has
entered into the agreement, ensures compliance with
guidance specified in the agreement with respect to
the use of such personal protective equipment.

17 (c) GUIDANCE.—Not later than 90 days after the date on which the Secretary completes the review under 18 19 subsection (a), the Secretary shall issue guidance (based 20 on the results of such review) on requirements to include 21 under the agreements specified in such subsection, to en-22 sure the prevention and mitigation of spills of AFFF. 23 Such guidance shall include, at a minimum, best practices 24 and recommended requirements to ensure the following: 3

(1) The supervision by personnel trained in re sponding to spills of AFFF of each material transfer
 or maintenance activity carried out pursuant to such
 an agreement that may result in such a spill.

5 (2) The use of containment berms and the cov-6 ering of storm drains and catch basins by personnel 7 performing maintenance activities pursuant to such 8 an agreement in the vicinity of such drains or ba-9 sins.

10 (3) The storage of materials for the cleanup
11 and containment of AFFF in close proximity to fire
12 suppression systems in buildings of the Department
13 and the presence of such materials during any trans14 fer or activity specified in paragraph (1).

(d) BRIEFING.—Not later than 30 days after the date
on which the Secretary issues the guidance under subsection (c), the Secretary shall provide to the congressional
defense committees a briefing that summarizes the results
of the review conducted under subsection (a) and the guidance issued under subsection (c).

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
