At the end of title II, add the following:

1 SEC. ____. REFERENCES TO OPIOID OVERDOSE REVERSAL 2 AGENTS IN HHS GRANT PROGRAMS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and 4 Human Services shall ensure that, as appropriate, when-5 ever the Department of Health and Human Services issues a regulation or guidance for any grant program ad-6 dressing opioid misuse and use disorders, any reference 7 to an opioid overdose reversal drug (such as a reference 8 to naloxone) is inclusive of any opioid overdose reversal 9 10 drug that has been approved under section 505 of the Fed-11 eral Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 355) for 12 emergency treatment of a known or suspected opioid over-13 dose.

14 (b) EXISTING REFERENCES.—

(1) UPDATE.—Not later than one year after the
date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
Health and Human Services shall update all references described in paragraph (2) to be inclusive of
any opioid overdose reversal drug that has been ap-

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1	proved or otherwise authorized for use by the Food
2	and Drug Administration.
3	(2) References.—A reference described in
4	this paragraph is any reference to an opioid overdose
5	reversal drug (such as naloxone) in any regulation or
6	guidance of the Department of Health and Human
7	Services that—
8	(A) was issued before the date of enact-
9	ment of this Act; and
10	(B) is included in—
11	(i) the grant program for State and
12	Tribal response to opioid use disorders
13	under section 1003 of the 21st Century
14	Cures Act (42 U.S.C. 290ee–3 note) (com-
15	monly referred to as "State Opioid Re-
16	sponse Grants" and "Tribal Opioid Re-
17	sponse Grants"); or
18	(ii) the grant program for priority
19	substance use disorder prevention needs of
20	regional and national significance under
21	section 516 of the Public Health Service
22	Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–22).

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
