At the end of title I, add the following:

1	SEC REPORT ON WATER STORAGE PRICING FOR-

3	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—
4	(1) due to the ongoing drought in many parts
5	of the United States, communities are looking for
6	ways to enhance their water storage on Corps of En-
7	gineer reservoirs so as to maintain a reliable supply
8	of water into the foreseeable future;
9	(2) water storage pricing formulas should be
10	equitable and not create disparities between users;
11	and
12	(3) water pricing formulas should not be cost-
13	prohibitive for communities.
14	(b) Assessment.—
15	(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
16	after the date of enactment of this Act, the Comp-
17	troller General of the United States shall initiate an
18	assessment of the water storage pricing formulas of

the Corps of Engineers, which shall include an as sessment of—

3 (A) existing water storage pricing formulas
4 of the Corps of Engineers, in particular wheth5 er those formulas produce water storage costs
6 for some beneficiaries that are greatly disparate
7 from the costs of other beneficiaries; and

8 (B) whether equitable water storage pric-9 ing formulas could lessen the disparate impact 10 and produce more affordable water storage for 11 potential beneficiaries.

12 (2) REPORT.—The Comptroller General shall
13 submit to Congress a report on the assessment car14 ried out under paragraph (1).
