1 SEC. 19. RISK-COMMUNICATION STRATEGY.

The Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall develop a risk-communication strategy to inform the public about the hazards or potential hazards of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, or categories of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, by—

- 8 (1) disseminating information about the risks 9 or potential risks posed by such substances or cat-10 egories in land, air, water (including drinking 11 water), and products;
- (2) notifying the public about exposure pathways and mitigation measures through outreach and
 educational resources; and

(3) consulting with States that have dem-onstrated effective risk-communication strategies for

- 1 best practices in developing a national risk-commu-
- 2 nication strategy.
