At the end of the committee print, insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 19. RISK-COMMUNICATION STRATEGY.

2 The Administrator of the Environmental Protection
3 Agency shall develop a risk-communication strategy to in-
4 form the public about the hazards or potential hazards
5 of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, or cat-
6 egories of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances,
7 by—

8 (1) disseminating information about the risks
9 or potential risks posed by such substances or cat-
10 egories in land, air, water (including drinking
11 water), and products;

12 (2) notifying the public about exposure path-
13 ways and mitigation measures through outreach and
14 educational resources; and

15 (3) consulting with States that have dem-
16 onstrated effective risk-communication strategies for
