Page 191, after line 6, insert the following:

1SEC. 356. IMPLEMENTATION OF COMPTROLLER GENERAL2RECOMMENDATIONS RELATING TO MITIGA-3TION AND PREVENTION OF TRAINING ACCI-4DENTS.

5 (a) REQUIREMENTS.—The Secretary of the Defense
6 shall take such steps as may be necessary to carry out
7 the following with respect to the Army, Navy, Marine
8 Corps, and Air Force:

9 (1) To develop more clearly defined roles for ve-10 hicle commanders and establish mechanisms and 11 procedures for tactical vehicle risk management to 12 be used by first-line supervisors, including vehicle 13 commanders.

(2) To evaluate the number of personnel within
operational units who are responsible for tactical vehicle safety and determine if these units are appropriately staffed, or if any adjustments are needed to
workloads or resource levels to implement operational unit ground-safety programs.

1	(3) To ensure that tactical vehicle driver train-
2	ing programs, including licensing, unit, and follow-
3	on training programs, have a well-defined process
4	with specific performance criteria and measurable
5	standards to identify driver skills and experience
6	under diverse conditions.
7	(4) To evaluate—
8	(A) the extent to which ranges and train-
9	ing areas are fulfilling responsibilities to iden-
10	tify and communicate hazards to units; and
11	(B) to the extent to which such responsibil-
12	ities are not being carried out, whether existing
13	solutions are adequate or if additional resources
14	should be applied to fulfill such responsibilities.
15	(b) Consultation Requirement.—The Secretary
16	of the Army, the Secretary of the Navy, the Secretary of
17	the Air Force, and the Commandant of the Marine Corps
18	shall jointly establish a formal collaboration forum among
19	Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps range officials
20	through which such officials shall share methods for iden-
21	tifying and communicating hazards to units.
