At the end of subtitle D of title VIII, insert the following new section:

1	SEC. 8 ASSESSMENT OF CRITICAL DEFENSE MINERAL
2	SUPPLY CHAIN VULNERABILITIES.
3	(a) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of the
4	United States shall conduct an assessment of the supply
5	chains of critical defense minerals for the defense indus-
6	trial base to identify vulnerabilities in such supply chains.
7	(b) Report.—Not later than 365 days after the date
8	of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of
9	the United States shall submit to Committees on Armed
10	Services of the House of Representatives and Senate a re-
11	port on the findings of the assessment conducted under
12	subsection (a), including—
13	(1) an identification of each source of each crit-
14	ical defense mineral described in such subsection;
15	(2) an evaluation of the barriers to expanding
16	the domestic capacity for mining and producing such
17	critical defense minerals; and

1	(3) recommendations for Congress and appro-
2	priate Federal agencies to incentivize the domestic
3	production of such critical defense minerals.
1	(c) Critical Defense Minerals Defined.—In
5	this section, the term "critical defense mineral" means a
6	mineral that is essential to manufacturing to supply the
7	military, industrial, and essential civilian needs of the
3	United States for national defense, including rare earth
)	elements, lithium, cobalt, and nickel.
