At the appropriate place in subtitle A of title XIII, insert the following:

4	(1) reaffirms the commitments of the United
5	States to the Taiwan Relations Act (22 U.S.C.
6	3301) and the Six Assurances;
7	(2) further reaffirms the United States contin-
8	ued diplomatic and military coordination with Tai-
9	wan;
10	(3) condemns the Government of the People's
11	Republic of China's military escalations toward Tai-
12	wan;
13	(4) encourages the Secretary of Defense to con-
14	tinue to engage in security talks with Taiwan and
15	regional allies with the aim of deterring military
16	threats posed by the Government of the People's Re-
17	public of China toward Taiwan;
18	(5) affirms the United States commitment, in
19	accordance with the Taiwan Relations Act, to main-

tain the capacity of the United States to resist any
 resort to force or other forms of coercion that would
 jeopardize the security, or the social or economic
 system, of the people on Taiwan;

5 (6) further affirms that it is the policy of the
6 United States of America to maintain the capacity
7 of the United States to resist a fait accompli that
8 would jeopardize the security of the people on Tai9 wan by the Government of the People's Republic of
10 China; and

(7) supports policies that increase the freedom
of trade and commerce between the United States
and Taiwan.
